

PhD student position in the Cejka laboratory (IRB Bellinzona, Switzerland)

Mechanisms of DNA repair by Homologous Recombination

The Cejka laboratory is looking for enthusiastic candidates for a PhD student position. Our international team will welcome individuals with a Master's degree in molecular/cellular/cancer biology or related fields, who are interested in mechanistic studies. Our laboratory investigates how cell repair broken DNA (<https://www.irb.usi.ch/irb-people/cejka-petr/?id=8994>). The research will focus on elucidating the functions of DNA metabolic proteins in mitochondria.

The research will be carried out at the Institute for Biomedical Research in Bellinzona, (<http://www.irb.usi.ch/>), which is internationally recognized as a center of excellence in biomedical research and human immunology. The PhD student will be part of a PhD program at the Università della Svizzera italiana, a rapidly developing center in southern Switzerland. The PhD salary is determined by the Swiss National Science Foundation scales and is fully sufficient to cover living expenses.
